Camp Descriptions

Rocketry & Flight – If it flies, glides, hovers, hangs, shoots, or blasts off, we'll be building it. We will create and alter wing design planes that dive, dip, loop, and spin across the sky. We will learn about propulsion and air power as we create and build marshmallow launchers. And for all you aero-maniacs out there we will be launching rockets NASA style.

Kitchen Chemistry – All young scientists enjoy mixing up concoctions of foods to see what they can produce. They will be introduced to many recipes and mixtures that not only create food, but toys as well. We will learn many concepts in chemistry by experimenting with kitchen ingredients. Students will come away from this class with a new appreciation of what is involved in making their favorite meals and learn that kitchen ingredients can make more than food.
